Call for Papers

ISRM 2019 aims to promote timely scholarly exchange for the robotics and mechatronics R&D community. This is the sixth in the series following the previous ones held in Vietnam (2009), China (2011), Singapore (2013), France (2015), and Australia (2017). Hosted by National Taiwan University of Science and Technology (Taiwan Tech), ISRM 2019 is an event organized by the Technical Committee for Robotics and Mechatronics under the International Federation for the Promotion of Mechanism and Machine Science (IFTToMM).

Topics: Papers are solicited on robotics, mechatronics and related areas within aspects of theory, design, practice, and applications in engineering, including but not limited to: *mechanism synthesis, analysis and design, modelling and simulation, kinematics and dynamics of multibody systems, control methods, navigation and motion planning, sensors and actuators, novel robotic systems: soft robotics, bio-robotics, micro/nano-robotics, complex robotic systems, walking machines and humanoids, smart devices, industrial, service and field robotics and mechatronics application and prototypes, and education and historic trends in robotics and mechatronics.*

Contributed Papers: Original papers must be submitted in PDF format. Manuscript templates and the submission method are available on the conference website. Only papers for which at least one author has registered for ISRM 2019 will be accepted by the conference and be included in the proceedings. The proceedings of ISRM 2019 will be published by Springer in the *Mechanisms and Machine Science bookseries*.

Venue: Taiwan Tech is located in the Taipei downtown area about a ten-minute walk from the Gong-Guan MRT (Taipei Metro) station. International visitors can fly to Taipei by using either Taiwan Taoyuan International Airport (TPE) or Taipei Songshan Airport (TSA). Public transportation, e.g., city metro, buses, taxis, and bikes, are safe and easily accessible to travel around Taipei city.

IFTToMM Young Delegate Program will be available to provide some financial assistance to young scientists and engineers under the age of 35 years to participate in ISRM 2019.

Registration Fee: The fee includes the admission to technical sessions, welcome reception, banquet, lunches, coffee breaks, conference tour, and access to conference e-proceedings.
